Opening of new Athletics Track at annual Frühlingsfest 17 May 2014

In the presence of the former Mayor of Starnberg, Herr Ferdinand Pfaffinger, parents, students and staff and other members of the School community gathered at Munich International School (MIS) on 17 May to open the new Athletics Track and Field facilities as part of the School's annual Frühlingsfest.

This is a major milestone in the achievement of the School's campus expansion programme and fulfillment of its mission – *Excellence in education for globally-minded students*.

The new Athletics Track and Soccer Field expands MIS' current outdoor facilities to offer students some of the best sporting facilities amongst international schools. On 21-24 May 2014 MIS will host the International Schools Sports Tournament (ISST) for the first time at the Starnberg campus.

Ms Wanching Ang, Chair of the Board of Directors, expressed her gratitude for the support MIS has received from the community for these projects, most particularly the MIS Sport Verein that has donated another cheque of €40,000 towards these new facilities.

The opening of the new track took place during the School's 46th annual Frühlingsfest, an event organised by the MIS Parents Verein that was established in February 1967 in the very first year of the School's history.

Simon Taylor, Head of School, said: "Munich International School has always aimed to provide the very best education for its students. Our Parent and Sport Vereins have been at the heart of these endeavours since the School's earliest days and so it is fitting that the opening of the new track and field should coincide with our annual Frülingsfest."

Leonne Francot, Chief Operations Officer, added: "The opening of the Athletics Track and Field is a major milestone in the realisation of the School's Strategic Plan; providing students with an outstanding all-round education and multiple opportunities to excel."
