



SCHOOL FEE REDUCTION PROGRAMME (SFRP)

Terms and conditions for school year 2026/27
(for SFRP applications received 01.08.2026 or later)

The MIS School Fee Reduction Programme is a need-based financial aid program aiming at making education at MIS accessible to students regardless of their economic status.

Eligibility

- Student is currently enrolled at MIS or has formally received an offer of admission from the Admissions Office to attend grade 1–12 in school year 2026/27.
- Furthermore, the student's eligibility for SFRP must be established through the completion of a School Fee Reduction Programme Application, which requires the timely submission of detailed family financial information.
- Student's household net worth must not exceed €1.0m.
- SFRP applications submitted prior to 1st August 2026 are subject to terms and conditions valid at that time and cannot be resubmitted.

School Fee Reduction

- School fee reduction is determined by the SFRP table below, which sets school fee cap per student depending on the expected annual household net income in the respective school year.

- In addition, school fee reduction is further adjusted to guarantee that annual household net income after deducting school fees does not fall below the household's subsistence minimum ("Existenzminimum"). Number of adults and dependent children in the household are considered to determine the household's subsistence minimum in Germany.

- SFRP covers mandatory school fees only. Optional fees (e.g. extracurricular activities, cafeteria, bus fees) are not covered.
- School Fee Reductions are granted for one academic year only and must be reapplied for annually.

Application process

- SFRP applications for school year 2026/27 submitted prior to 1st August 2026 have been assessed according to SFRP terms valid at the time of their submission. Re-submissions for school year 2026/27 are not accepted.
- SFRP applications for existing students are accepted on a rolling basis, but no later than 1st March for the upcoming school year. Newly admitted students must submit SFRP application within 4 weeks of the initial offer from the Admissions Office, but no later than 1st May.
- Disclosure of financial information is required. MIS reserves the right to request clarifications and/or additional information to evaluate the application.
- SFRP applications, submitted documents, and decisions made are confidential, with procedures in alignment with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the respective German regulations.
- Decisions regarding SFRP are final and cannot be appealed.
- Submission of an SFRP application does not automatically guarantee the granting of a school fee reduction.
- SFRP is a rules-based system based on criteria laid out in this document. No other judgmental criteria are taken into consideration.

Based on the review of the SFRP application, MIS may request further necessary information or documentation.
